Proverbs 3:1-10 is one of my favorite passages from the Bible. *"My son, do not forget my law, but let your heart keep my commands; for length of days and long life and peace they will add to you."* When I heed God's instructions, I receive the benefits. I think you get the picture. I can only see what I can see. God sees everything. If I want to have plenty and have my life to be full, then I must follow God's instructions. I must honor Him first, THEN the blessings will be mine. Enough. Have a wonderful rest of your week. I want all that God has for me. I will honor Him and follow Him. Will you? MB
