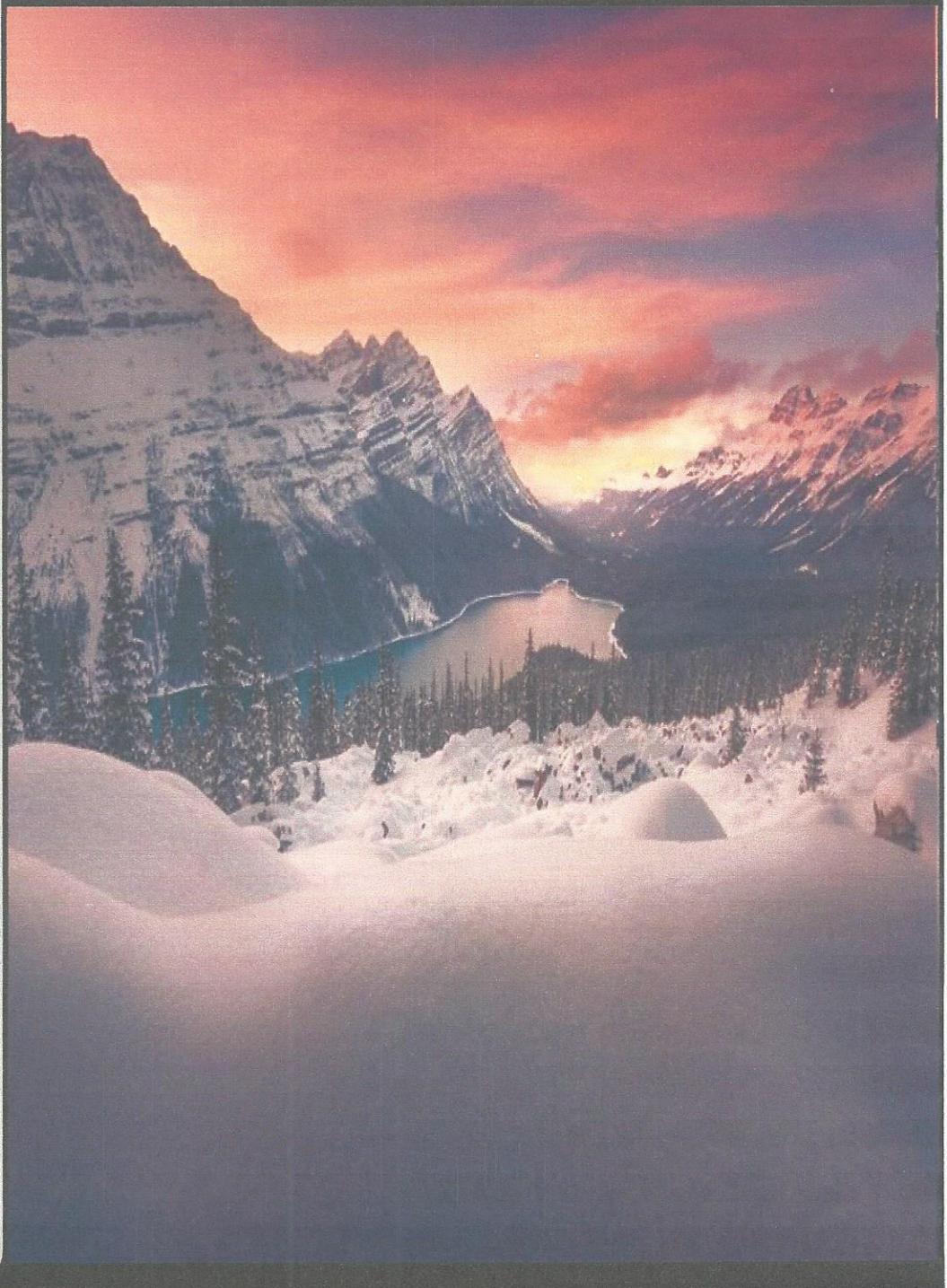

Good morning to you on this beautiful wintry Sunday! I hope you have fared well through this cold and icy weather. We welcome every member of the Harding Street Church of Christ and our guests today. Let us continue in prayer for those who are sick or are in quarantine due to the virus. The numbers are falling. Congratulations to Carla Prysock, our newest sister in Christ at Harding Street. Carla experienced the joy of salvation in Christ when she was baptized into Christ this past Sunday morning. God is blessing us. It is so good to have the opportunity to meet together on the Lord's Day, the first day of the week. Today we will study the Bible together. When we study God's word our faith is stronger, our mind is sharper, and our confidence in Christ is reaffirmed after a week of life and living. We will pray together today. A family that prays together stays together. I know this sounds cliché, but it is true. We want to "be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment" (1 Corinthians 1:10). Today we will "lay something aside" giving as we have purposed in our hearts, not grudgingly or of necessity, but cheerfully and bountifully for the work of the church (1 Corinthians 16:1, 2 Corinthians 9:6-8). Our Sunday morning sermon today will help us "Find the Joy in Giving." God expects us to share our time, talent, and treasure to make the world better. Let us give generously, sacrificially, purposefully, creatively, and abundantly. Luke 6:38 is forever true. Have you tried it? If you have, you know. If you haven't, you're missing out. Remember Jesus, "It is more blessed to give than to receive." Tonight, at the 5:00 hour we will focus our attention on the "V" in BRAVE and find that Brave Christians Value God's Word. 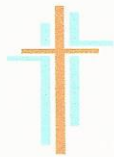
