If we follow His steps, we will also be where He is. There is no time to waste. Let's get to it.

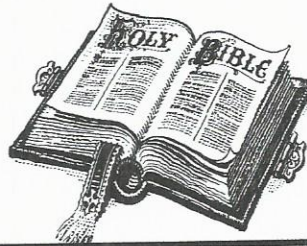
