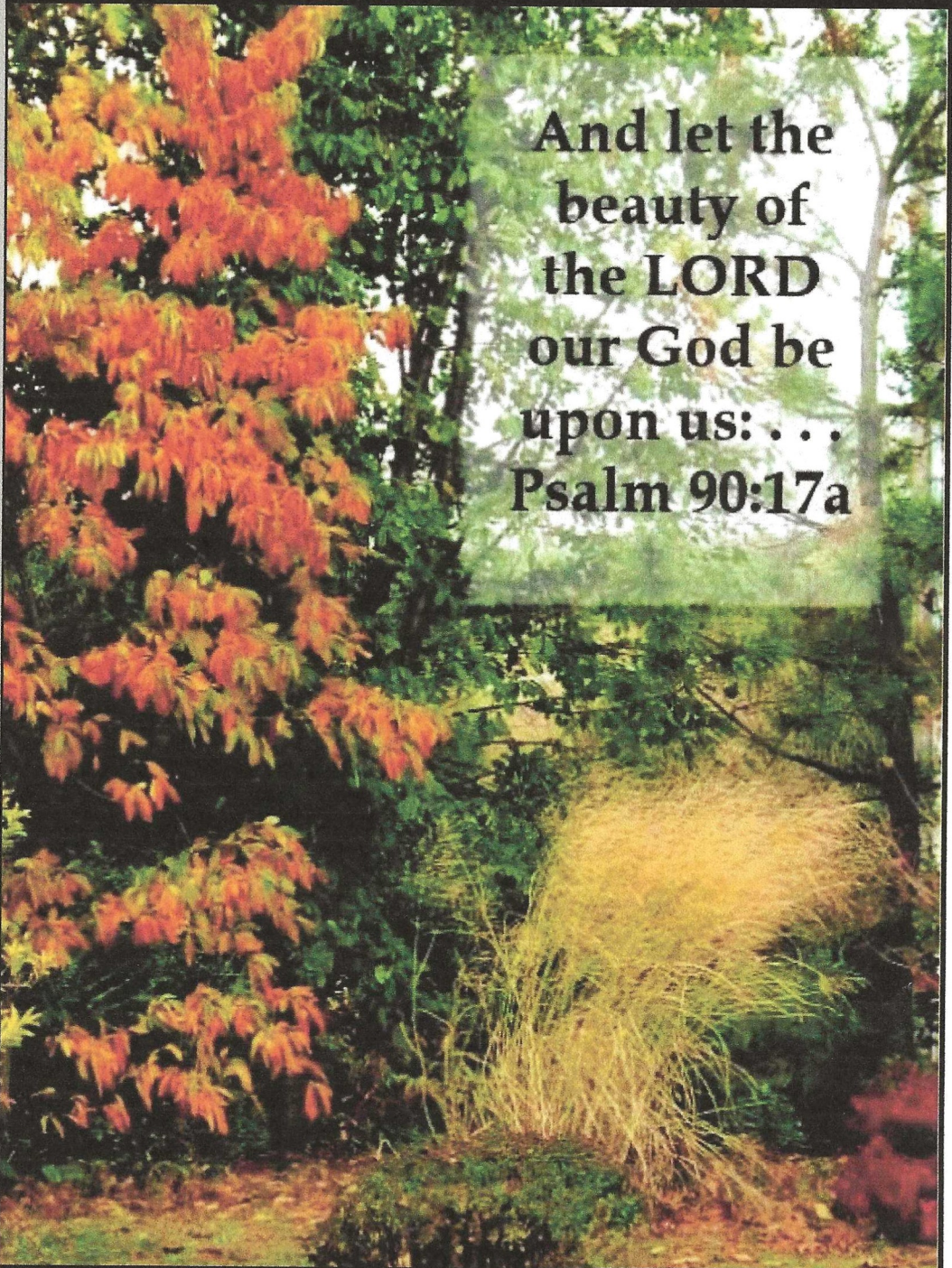

Thank you so much for allowing me to be away this past Sunday through Thursday to preach the gospel in South Carolina with the White Knoll Church of Christ in Lexington. Same for Noah, Abraham, Joseph, Daniel, Joshua, Micah, the rich young ruler, the apostles, and anyone and everyone in the world before us, presently, and those to follow. Come to Jesus. Fulfill your purpose and be blessed. Come to Jesus. Look beyond today into eternity. Come to Jesus. Count the cost. Come as you are. Jesus will save you. You will be so glad you did.

Sympathy is extended to Charles Camp and family on the loss of his brother, Jimmy Camp. He passed away early yesterday morning.

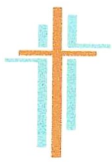
