Hello. We are so happy to be together today to worship God in spirit and in truth. I hope you will be encouraged and challenged by what you see, hear, speak, and do today. Even though Autumn has arrived (22nd), summer just doesn't seem to want to go away. We are still hot and dry, 100 degrees last week. We really need a good rain. And cooler temps would be very nice. God knows what He is doing. I'm glad. He has everything under control.

The Harding Street Church of Christ is doing well, continuing in the Way of Jesus Christ in word and deed. It seems that the world around us moves further and further away from the three solid principles we read about in Micah 6: justice, mercy, and humility. What does Hebrews 11:1 tell us about faith? "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." To His disciples He said, "Go, teach, BAPTIZE, and teach and He would be right there with them" (Matthew 28:18-20). It is true, that the Bible is a very old book. And it is also true that the Bible is still relevant, vibrant, alive, convicting, needed, and true yesterday, today, tomorrow, and forever.
