

After breakfast we would get dressed and after a motherly inspection leave the house for Bible class and worship. Cindi and I chose to follow a similar pattern for our family. I have found that my children, now grown are following a similar pattern for their family. I am thankful. How about you and your family? Create your own pattern of preparation and see if your Sunday mornings can be a joyful experience for you and yours. Thank you for the privilege of being your minister and friend. MB
