

Good morning. We are so blessed to have this day, Sunday, the Lord's Day to meet with family and friends to sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs together, pray together in the name of Jesus, give generously and gladly to further the gospel, hear a message from the Bible, and remember Christ's death and resurrection in the Lord's Supper. This we will do each and every Sunday until Jesus returns (1 Corinthians 11:26).

This past Wednesday evening Geoffrey taught in the main room about the need and necessity for people to worship God and the importance of meeting every Lord's Day to remember Jesus' sacrifice in the Lord's Supper. We know that the church of Christ in the Bible met on the first day of the week to pray, break bread, and hear the preaching of the gospel (Acts 20:7). We know that the church also gave from their financial blessings when they met on the first day of the week (1 Corinthians 16:1-2). On the first Pentecost after the ascension of Christ, the church of Christ came into being after Peter and the apostles preached in the power of the Holy Spirit. About 3,000 people received the word and were baptized (Acts 2:41). The next verse (42) tells us that they, the 3,000 with the apostles and the others who were among the 120 (Acts 1:14-15) "continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine (teaching) and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers." Note the spiritual context of these verses. Look further in Acts 2:46 to find a different context, a physical context when Luke writes, "So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart." Consider also in Hebrews 10:19-25 that God's word says, "Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus...let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith...not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching." Some today may teach and practice another way or another doctrine, but we will stay true to what we have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom we have learned them, and that from childhood we have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make us wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus (2 Timothy 3:14-16). This we will also do.
