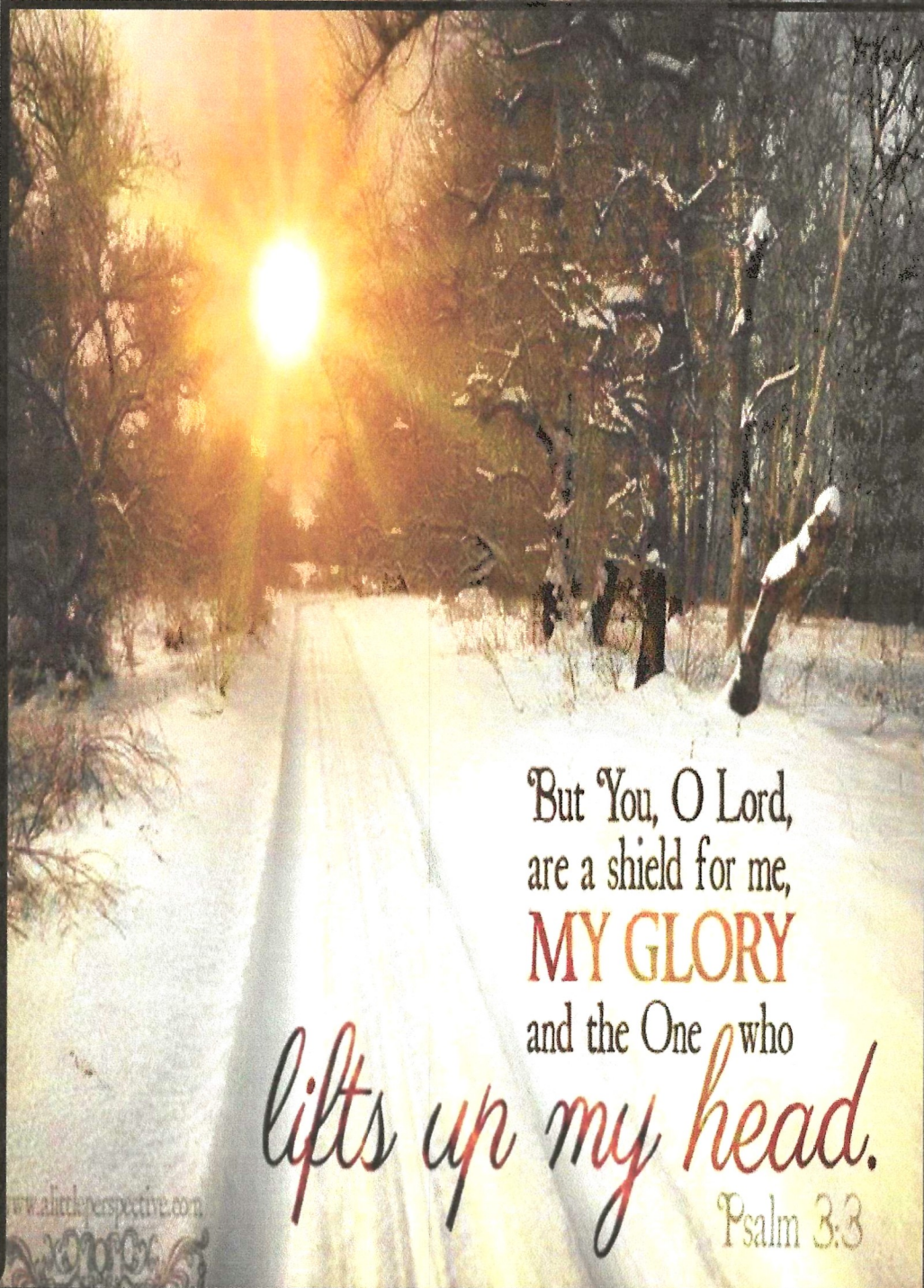

My, my how time keeps moving on. Today we will study the Bible together.
