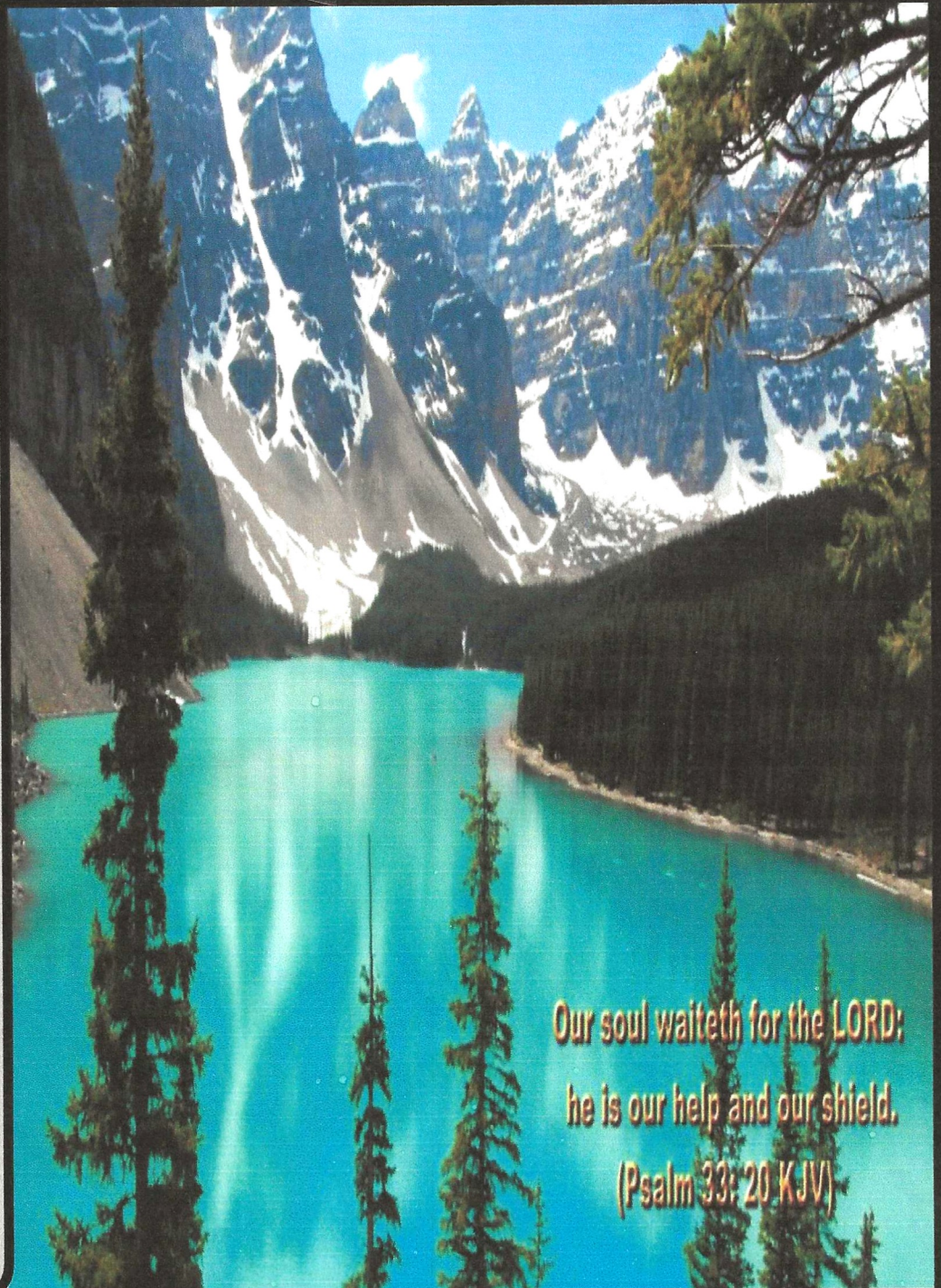

I do drink a cup of hot tea with a teaspoon of honey just about every day. Another quote from my grandmothers; "An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure." True.

What about our spiritual health? The old adage: "An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure" is true when it comes to our spiritual health too. Think about what God has told us in the Bible. In 1 John 2:1 we read; "My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous." The last part of this verse gives us the cure for sin, Jesus Christ. Sin is terrible. We must hate sin just like we hate COVID and the flu. Only Jesus can set us free from sin. 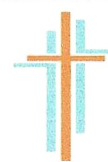
