

Some of the men of that place had enslaved this girl and profited from her. They became angry because Paul and Silas because now they couldn't profit from her. They took Paul and Silas and beat them with rods, put them in prison, and fastened their feet in stocks. Read Acts 16:24-25 to see what happened at midnight. All things worked together for good. Jesus always knew this fact. He had to live, learn, suffer, and die but all things worked together for good because He loved His Father and lived His life for His Father's purpose.

On the evening we will conclude last week's lesson, "Who is Jesus that anyone would follow Him? – Jesus is a Winner. MB
