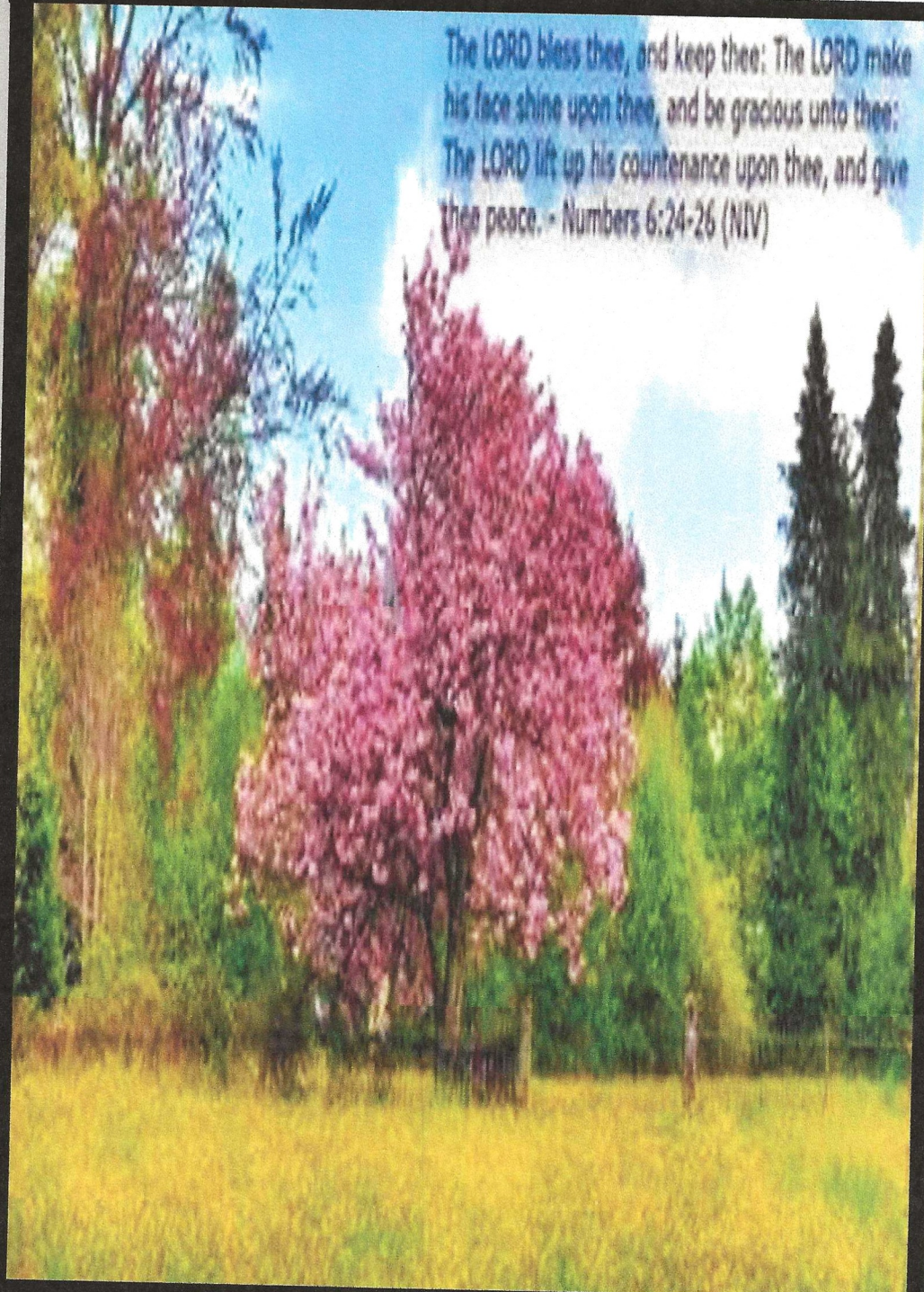

Good morning to you on this terrific Sunday in March! Did you remember to "spring forward" today? It is always a great privilege to meet together to worship God in spirit and in truth. The writer to the Hebrews said it this way in chapter 12, verses 1-2, "Let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith..." On then evening we will begin a new series entitled "Avoiding Foolish Decisions OR Four Foolish Things Christians Do to Mess Up Their Lives." We will look at Abram and Sarai in Genesis 12 and let them teach us what not to do.

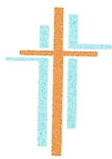

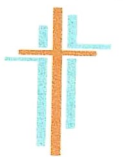
