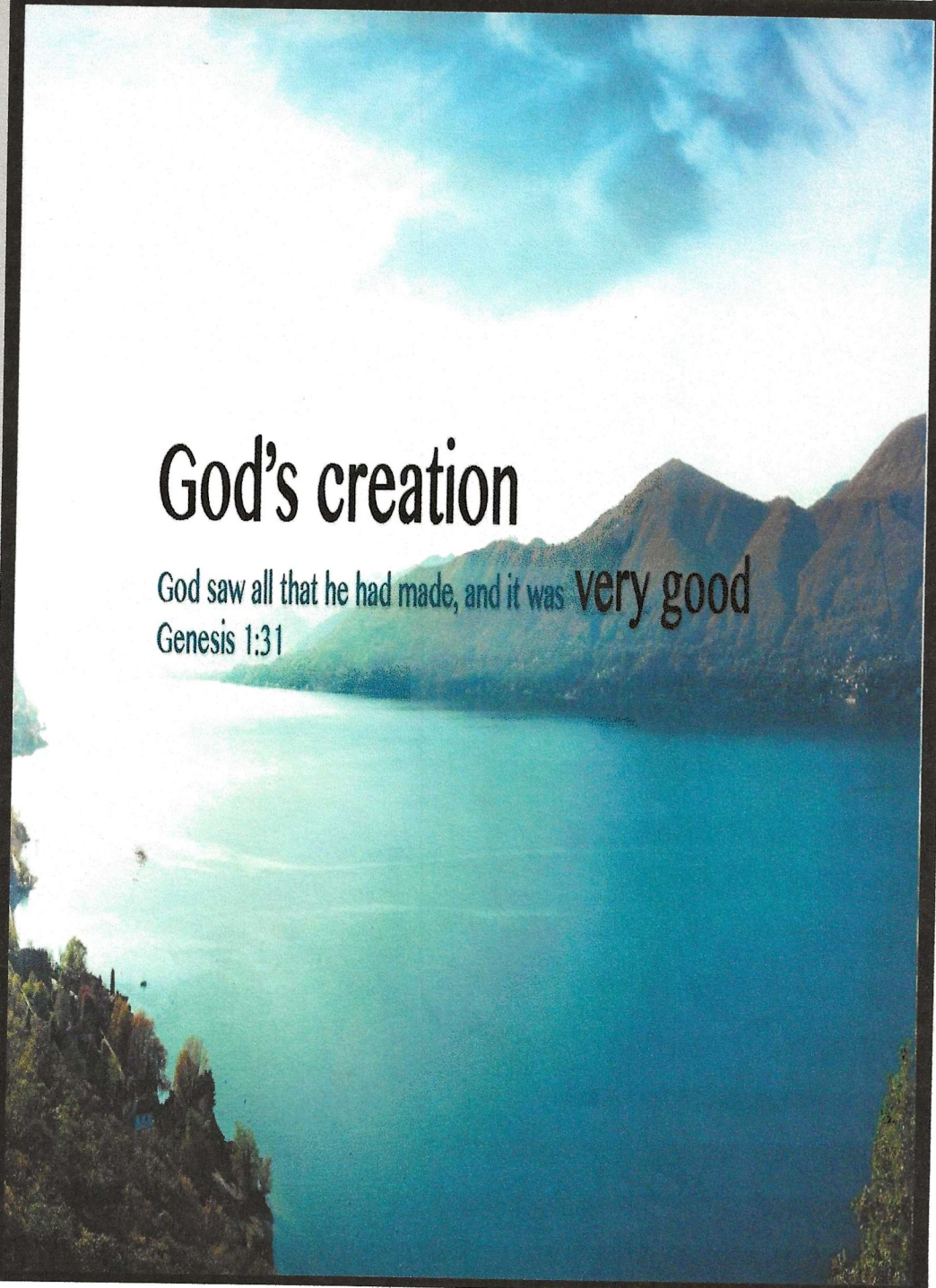

If we want the saved and the unsaved, the different and the indifferent to attend when the church meets together to hear the best news in all the world, we must let them know. If we really want them to come, we will find a way. This is our task and the duty of every member of the church of Christ at Harding Street. Let's do this. Jesus did. MB

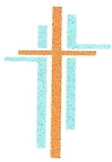

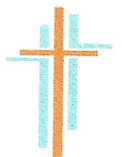
