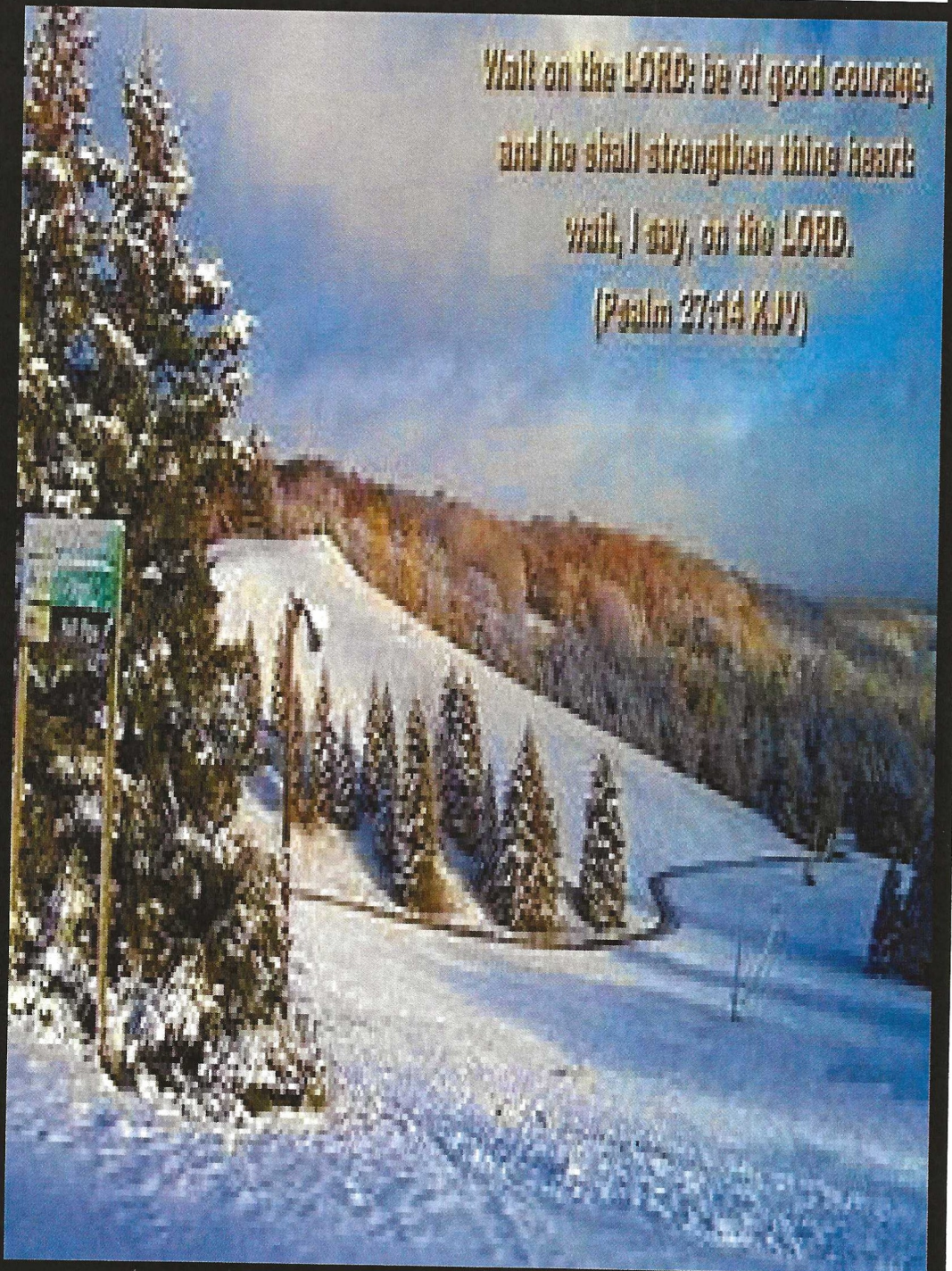

Good morning and welcome to Harding Street Church of Christ! I hope you had a great Thanksgiving this past week and got to enjoy time with your family. I hope you also took time to thank God for all that He has blessed you with. This week the verse that was on my heart and mind was **1 Peter 4:8**, “**Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.**” This is such a powerful verse, reminding us of the central role that love plays in our lives as followers of Christ. Peter calls us to prioritize love above all else, not as a fleeting emotion but as a deep, enduring commitment to one another. Peter says that this love has the power to “cover a multitude of sins.”

What does it mean for love to cover sins? It doesn't suggest ignoring wrongdoing, or pretending sin doesn't exist. Instead, it reflects the grace and forgiveness that we are called to extend to one another. When we love deeply, we choose to see people through a lens of grace, offering forgiveness and reconciliation rather than holding onto grudges or keeping a record of wrongs. This kind of love reflects the heart of Christ. Jesus showed us this love when He gave His life for our sins, demonstrating the ultimate act of grace. As His followers, we are to imitate that love in our relationships.

But how do we live out such love in a world that often promotes division, bitterness, and self-interest? We can start by following this four steps:

### **1. Be intentional in relationships:**

Deep love requires effort. We should take time to invest in relationships, offer encouragement, and actively listen to those around us.

### **2. Forgive as Christ forgave:**

When someone wrongs us, we have the choice to hold onto resentment or to forgive. Choose forgiveness, trusting that God's grace is sufficient for both you and the other person.

### **3. Serve others with a willing heart:**

Acts of love often involve putting others' needs before our own. Look for ways to serve your family, friends, and community by reflecting Christ sacrificial love

### **4. Pray for a loving spirit:**

Ask God to soften your heart and fill you with His love, so it can overflow into your relationships

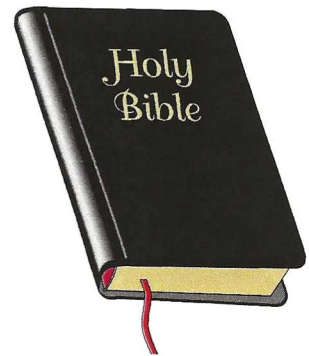
