Merry Christmas, and may the light of Christ shine brightly in your heart this season and always.

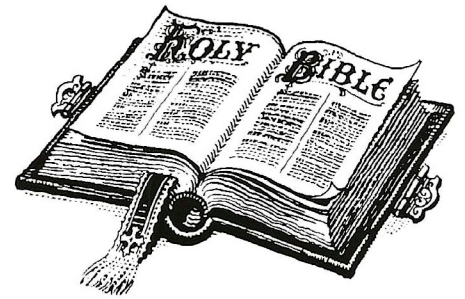

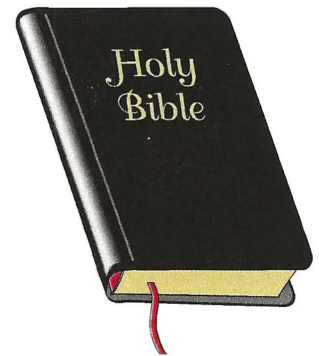
